

STUDENT INSTRUCTIONS

- 1) Log in to Whyville → Go to the Teleport Menu → PlaneWorks → WingFling.
- 2) Play the WingFling game with your classmates!
- 3) Complete the worksheet.

How to play WingFling:

Enter the room. To skip instructions, type “skip”, or “help” to repeat.

Gameplay:

Single Click (on a plane part): pick up part

Single Click (on the production bay): drop part in the production bay

You must move a 1) fuselage, 2) wings, and 3) engines to a production bay to complete an aircraft.

When the storage bins fill up and the conveyor belt has nowhere to put parts, the game will end.

Tips:

Make sure the parts match!

You'll receive clams for each part you place correctly.

Work with your classmates (multiple players at once) to place parts for as long as possible. Try out different strategies to maximize your score.

If the room gets too busy, remember there are 25 rooms to choose from. Jump to a new room using the drop-down menu found below the game.
